BREAKOUT..!!

NIFTY OUTLOOK



Nifty ended the week with a **Doji** right at the confluence of the weekly swing high and the falling 20 week EMA, both clustered near 24089, highlighting a clear battle between bulls and bears. Despite strong momentum on lower timeframes, the inability to decisively clear this higher timeframe resistance reaffirms that the weekly trend remains the dominant force.

The Doji formation reflects indecision, but it also signals that supply is gradually getting absorbed. A sustained breakout and weekly close above 24100 would invalidate the falling EMA resistance and trigger a fresh round of short covering, initially paving the way toward 24250 and subsequently 24500.

On the downside, the weekly gap near 23817 remains the first line of defence for bulls and should act as an immediate cushion on any pullback. Below that, 23700 emerges as the next key demand zone. Daily and lower timeframe moving averages remain firmly bullish, and a decisive move above 24100 could unlock fresh momentum and shift the higher timeframe structure back in favour of bulls.

Support: 23817, 23700

Resistance: 24250, 24500

Strategy : Buy above 24100 for a target of 24250, with a stop loss below 24025.

BANK NIFTY OUTLOOK



Bank Nifty continues to display strong relative strength against Nifty, with price action holding firm despite overhead resistance. The broader structure remains constructive as moving averages across both weekly and lower timeframes are positively aligned and continue to act as dynamic support. The weekly order block near 57800 capped the index throughout the week, but the absence of a meaningful rejection or downside follow through suggests that bulls are gradually absorbing supply rather than losing momentum.

This behaviour typically precedes an expansion move once resistance gives way. A decisive breakout above the 57800–58000 zone could trigger a fresh round of short covering and momentum buying, opening the path toward the unfilled weekly gap near 60177.5. On the downside, the weekly gap around 57076 remains the first line of support and is expected to cushion any short term pullback. Below that, 56600 serves as the next important demand zone.

Momentum indicators remain constructive and continue to support the case for a sustained upside move once the current resistance barrier is decisively breached.

Support: 57076, 56600

Resistance: 57800–58000, 60177.5

Strategy : Buy above 57800 for a target of 58800, with a stop loss below 57500.



POWER PLAY STOCK PICKS FOR THE WEEK



TRANSFORMERS AND RECTIFIERS LTD .



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TARIL has confirmed a breakout from a bullish 30-week cup-and-handle formation after successfully closing the final bearish runaway gap, signalling a decisive shift in long-term trend structure. The follow-through move has been accompanied by strong price action and rising volumes, particularly on the right side of the pattern, indicating meaningful institutional participation.

This combination of gap closure, volume expansion, and breakout confirmation strengthens the probability of sustained upside momentum. The stock appears to be transitioning from an accumulation phase into a fresh expansion cycle, with moving averages providing dynamic support beneath price. As long as the breakout zone holds, bulls are likely to remain in control and drive the next leg of the rally.

Physics Wallah has finally confirmed a breakout from a bullish cup-and-handle formation after enduring three sharp shakeouts near the 115 level. The repeated liquidity sweeps successfully eliminated weak holders, allowing stronger hands to accumulate positions before the breakout. T

he stock has now delivered an IPO base breakout above 116, supported by a substantial 242% surge in volumes compared to the 50-day average, signalling broad-based institutional participation. The strength of the breakout suggests a transition from accumulation to expansion, with momentum likely to build further in the coming sessions. As long as the stock sustains above the breakout zone, the bullish structure remains intact and follow-through buying is expected to support higher levels.

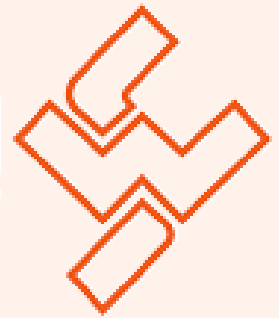

SW Solar has displayed strong institutional accumulation throughout its 26-week base formation, suggesting that the consolidation phase was driven by strategic buying rather than distribution. The breakout is now being reinforced by a sharp 242% surge in daily volumes, signalling broad-based participation and strengthening the probability of trend continuation.

Price structure across multiple timeframes remains constructive, with both weekly and lower timeframe moving averages aligned positively beneath price. This alignment creates a strong technical launchpad for a sustained upside move. The combination of institutional accumulation, volume expansion, and supportive moving averages indicates that bulls remain firmly in control. Any retest of the breakout zone is likely to attract fresh buying interest rather than aggressive selling pressure.
